# Tobacco Treatment Training Program- Lifelong Medical

- ▶ Contracted by Alameda County Behavioral Health Services (ACBH) and Tobacco Control Public Health (TCP) to support all provider networks within Alameda County to increase community access to tobacco treatment
- ▶ We support health care and behavioral health systems
  - ▶ Evidence-based, skill-building quarterly trainings
  - ▶ Tobacco Treatment Specialist cohorts (May 2022)
  - ▶ Staff trainings
  - ▶ Assist programs with tobacco policy implementation
  - ▶ Support clinical systems in augmenting tobacco tx & workflows
  - ▶ Support EHR adaptation and direct referrals to the California Smokers' Helpline (Ask Advise-Connect)
